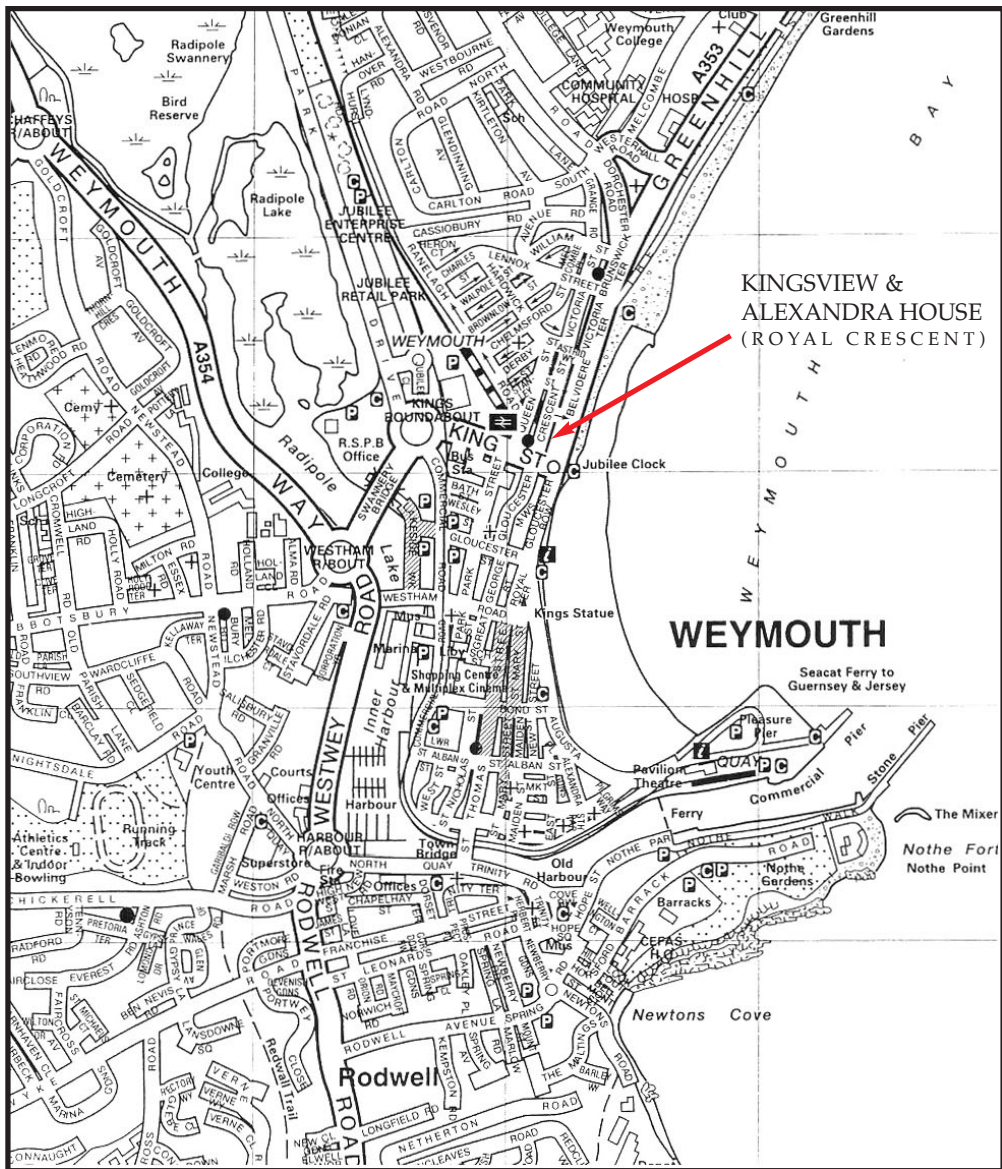










STREET MAP - SCALE 4 INCHES TO 1 MILE

Kingsview and Alexandra House are centrally located, in one of the magnificent seafront terraces, opposite the Jubilee Clock. From the upper floors both properties enjoy panoramic views over the dramatic sweep of Weymouth bay. The buildings were constructed at the turn of the 18th century during the patronage of the town by King George III.

Weymouth has preserved much of its history alongside the contemporary assets of a modern seaside resort. The apartments offer an ideal location from which to explore the more remote parts of the spectacular Dorset countryside and coastline, now designated a Natural World Heritage Site.
